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ABC BEGINNING OF THE YEAR LIST:

- ABC's Code of Conduct: All students are encouraged to follow our ABC's Code of Conduct stressing the importance of Attitude, Behavior, and Courtesy. These guidelines are found in the Handbook.
- Child Care is available at the Child Development Center from 7:00 am-6:00 pm each day. If you plan to enroll, or would like more information, please call Melanie Francis at 453-3332 Ext. 115.
- **Children's Choir** for 3rd-8th graders will be on Tuesdays from 3:20-4:20. Sign-ups will be held at the Meet & Greet on August 24th, or you may use the online form. Mrs. Kathleen Houdek is returning as choir director.
- **Coaches/Advisors/Officers:** We ask that if you are an Advisor for an after school club and/or evening event, please contact the school office at least one month ahead to schedule a meeting date, time and location. By scheduling a meeting room one month in advance, we can add the event to the monthly calendar as well as ensure you a meeting location.
- **Directory:** Our Holy Spirit School Family Directory will be available for you in September. If you prefer to have your home phone number or email identified as unlisted in the directory, or if your address, phone number or email address has changed since March, please contact the school office by August 24th. Unless notified, your contact information will be published within the directory.
- **Dress Code:** School uniforms begin with the start of school on August 28th for students in grades 1-8. Please be sure to consult the Holy Spirit School Uniform Code as you do your back to school shopping and before you remove the sales tag. As you order, keep in mind that the length for skirts and shorts for girls is no more than 4 inches above the middle of the knees, so please factor this in to plan for growth and appropriate length in the spring. You may access the *Holy Spirit Uniform Code* on line under Parent Forms.
- **Drop-off/pick-up procedures** are available for you online under Parent Forms. All car-riders will be dropped-off in the back parking lot of school each morning no earlier than 8:05 am, at which time there will be designated supervising teachers on duty. In case of inclement weather, students will be instructed by the AM Recess Supervisors to go directly to their classrooms. To ensure proper supervision of the children, all afternoon car-riders (Kdg- 8th Grade) must be picked up in the back parking lot of school excluding the western edge of the Parish Offices/Church. We appreciate your cooperation and support with this, as we strive to create the safest environment for your children.
- Festival Volunteers and Donations: There will be a \$1 per family Color Day on Monday, September 11th to support the Kids' Tent for Festival. Volunteers are needed to help run games in the kids' tent at our Parish Festival on September 16-17. Please sign up through Sign Up Genius on the parish website.
- Free or Reduced Price Hot Lunch/Milk: In light of Michigan's difficult economic climate, we ask each school family to please review the attached letter and review the income chart to determine if your child/children qualify for free or reduced priced lunches as well as free milk. Participation in this program helps your budget and also determines the amount of federal funding for which Holy Spirit qualifies.
- Hot Lunch and Milk Orders: You may use the Deposit Payment Form from the school website and pay with cash or check, or pay online through the Infinite Campus website by clicking the Hot Lunch Electronic Funds Link. These programs will begin on Monday, August 28th. Please keep this payment separate from other fees to the school.
- Lunch/Recess Supervision Sign-up: To ensure the safety of the children while at lunch and recess, we will continue to utilize supervisors and parent volunteers to assist us at lunch/recess. Please see the attached letter which outlines the specifics of the program, as well as the months each grade level is responsible for lunch supervision.

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- **Medications:** Parents who have **children who will be on medications** this year may begin to bring the medications into the school office beginning Monday, August 21st. A Medication Administration Release Form is required and available for you online for you to complete and leave on file in the school office.
- **Parent Volunteers:** In order to maintain compliance with the Diocesan mandates by the Diocese of Grand Rapids for all adult volunteers in our school, volunteers must attend a Protecting God's Children Training Session *before* working with our children. This includes going on field trips and attending class parties. To register, log onto *www.virtus.org...*go to "Registrations" on the left side...select "View a list of sessions"...scroll down to "Grand Rapids Diocese"...select a training session which is convenient for you... and then register for the training. There is no cost and enrollment is limited for each session, so please register at your earliest convenience to ensure you may attend the class of your preference. Some upcoming Virtus classes to consider are at Aquinas on 9/9 at 1:00, Holy Spirit on 9/10 at 1:30, Holy Family in Sparta on 9/14 at 6:30, and at Holy Family in Caledonia on 10/26 at 6:00.

- Vaccines Exemptions: Any parent/guardian who wants to claim a nonmedical waiver will need to receive education regarding the benefits of vaccination and the risks of disease from a county health department before obtaining the certified nonmedical waiver form through the local health department. The new rule requires the use of the State of Michigan nonmedical waiver form dated January 1, 2015. Children must be vaccinated or have the waiver prior to starting school.
- **Volunteer** often to be involved with your child and your community. Each family is expected to volunteer at least 30 hours at the school each year. There are many opportunities waiting just for you. Please ask if you have any questions as we would love to assist you in getting involved. We look forward to seeing your smiling faces around school!
