Parents/grandparents are welcome to stop in any time during library open hours to view and purchase books.

These books will be in stock and available to take home the same day, with payment made at the time of purchase. ***If you will be sending a check, please make it payable to Holy Spirit Parent/Teacher Association and remember to add 6% sales tax.***

The Book Fair Committee is also planning a Community/Parish Kickoff in the school library on Saturday, December 1st from 8:30-11:00am during the Christmas Breakfast. We will have teacher wish lists posted for each teacher based on selections they would love for their classrooms. These books will be available to purchase and donate. A donor's card will be placed in the book to make a permanent record of your generous donation.
