#### Did You Know for All Volunteers and Future Volunteers

- Did you know the Virtus "Protecting God's Children" class is now available online for volunteers? There is a time limit to completing it once you have signed up for it at <a href="https://www.virtus.org">www.virtus.org</a>.
- Did you know anyone that is considered an employee (lunch supervisors, substitute teachers, high school coaches, classroom aides, etc.) must take the <u>live</u> training?
- Did you know that if you took the class for another parish or school that you need to tell Diane so she can get Holy Spirit School added to your account?
- Did you know that if you took the class in another diocese that uses Virtus that we can get it transferred? Contact Diane so she can help make that happen.
- Did you know that auditors come to check each location to see if we are in compliance?
- Did you know that Holy Spirit has to have the Background Check and Standards of Ministerial Behavior on file for each volunteer to show the auditors?
- Did you know that Holy Spirit cannot see the background check results from other locations? That is why we have to run one on all volunteers.
- Did you know that we run updated background checks every 5 years?
- Did you know that we need to run a national background check if you have lived outside of Michigan since turning age 18?
- Did you know that we have to run everyone through the National Sex Offender website? Filling out the form completely and correctly with maiden names, race, etc. helps us determine if you are the person on the list or not. You would be surprised to see how common your name might be and how many times it might appear on the list of offenders.
- Did you know that all background check results are confidential?
- Did you know that we require all this to help create a safer environment for your children?

Students do not report for school that day. This
always includes Preschool and Child Care
Programs as well.
No Catholic Schools Transportation in the A.M. or
P.M. into the closed Public School District areas.
Catholic Schools Transportation will begin
transporting two hours after regular time. There
will be no AM Preschool or Y5's or AM
Kindergarten. Child Care will open at regular
time for those enrolled in the program.
No Catholic Schools Transportation into the
delayed district for the A.M. ONLY.

If school is closed because of inclement weather, all extra-curricular activities, including athletic events and practices, scheduled for Holy Spirit or for Holy Spirit teams on that day, will be cancelled. (Education Commission policy #2060.1)

On those winter days when school is open but you feel weather conditions are unsafe for your child to go to school, you may keep him or her home. However, we ask that you call school and let us know that you are keeping your child at home. While we do urge you to call school when your child will be absent, please don't call the school to ask if classes will be cancelled because of the weather. Instead, we urge you to monitor Grand Rapids area radio and television stations, or their web sites, which will be informed immediately of any cancellations or delays.
