Religious Education News

<u>First Communion:</u> The date for the celebration of First Communion is set for Saturday, May 1, 2021. The Masses will be at 10am and 1pm. Registration forms have been sent home. First Communicants that were not baptized here at Holy Spirit will need to send us a copy of their baptismal certificate. There are 3 white First Communion dresses (sizes 7, 10 & 10) and a boy's white shirt (10-12) available to anyone that would like them. Contact the Religious Ed office if interested. Here is a <u>LINK</u> to Michigan Church Supply Catalog if anyone is interested in purchasing First Communion items from them. This is the store that is located downtown on Division Ave.

<u>First Communion Parent Homework:</u> You will be receiving an email with the computer fillable parent homework for First Communion. This homework should be returned by April 1. Watching these videos during Lent will set an example for your children that faith formation is a lifelong process. If you completed the First Communion parent homework for a child last year, you do not have to redo it. We keep them on file. **Last Year's and This Year's First Communion Platemaking:** Any First Communicants from last year or this year that would like to make a commemorative plate should contact the Religious Ed Office by March 3. The cost is \$12.00 per plate payable with cash (exact amount please) or a check made out to Holy Spirit Religious Education. Payment is due by Friday, March 26. Due to COVID restrictions, we will have those attending school complete their plates in class on Monday, March 29.

<u>Confirmation:</u> Confirmation will be Tuesday, May 25 and Wednesday, May 26. You should have returned your child's registration and baptismal certificate, if your child was not baptized or did not receive First Communion, at Holy Spirit. A letter from the sponsor's parish indicating that they are qualified to be a sponsor is also due. If the sponsor is a registered parishioner at Holy Spirit, you do not need to ask us to send one. The time of the ceremony has not yet been determined, but it will be in the evening.

<u>Volunteers:</u> Although we are unable to have volunteers this year, we still need to keep our safe environment documents up to date. Background checks need to be renewed every five years. You may receive an email from *Virtus* requesting that you log into your account to complete an updated background check authorization form. The first question it will ask is whether or not you have lived outside of Michigan since turning age 18. Please answer **no** if you have always lived in Michigan. The prompts will also ask you to read and electronically sign the Standards of Ministerial Behaviors. Please check that your email address is current on your Virtus account. If you need your log in information, let me know.
