Religious Education News

First Communion: You should have received an email about your scheduled time for the Mass on May 1. We are in need of a few more Eucharistic Ministers for the 10:00 am Mass. Ushers would be helpful at both Masses. Contact the Religious Ed Office if you can help us out with this. I will be practicing with the children during school hours using their assigned location on the seating chart so they should be able to find their seats quickly on that day. Your immediate family and guests will all be seated together. Your child should sit next to the sign with the family name printed on the colored paper. We ask that you please plan to be <u>seated</u> 15 minutes before your scheduled Mass. You will need to check in as you arrive. There should be no socializing in the narthex for social distancing purposes. Certificates and name tags will be in the pews. The commemorative plates should be picked up AFTER Mass to avoid breakage.

Confirmation: The Mass time for both Confirmation Masses will be 7:00 pm to allow you time to get home from work and get ready. You should plan to be seated 15 minutes before your Mass. You will need to check in as you arrive. There should be no socializing in the narthex for social distancing purposes. Dress should be modest and church appropriate. Dresses, skirts, or dress pants are acceptable for the girls. Boys usually wear dress pants, shirt, and tie. Suits are up to the parents. Your immediate family and guests will be seated together. Certificates and name tags will be in the pews when you arrive.

We are asking students to please refrain from lip syncs. All vocal pieces should have karaoke-style or live music for accompaniment.

The variety show entry form is to be turned into the school office by **Friday**, **April 30th**. Please be sure to fill out the form and read this letter completely with your parents, so you understand all the rules. Each participant must have his/her parent's signature.

Acts should be no longer than 2 minutes. Parents, please listen to the music your child has chosen as well as approving dance moves, jokes, and costuming. If deemed inappropriate and/or suggestive, your child will be asked to choose different music, dance moves, and/or costuming.

Rehearsal and approval dates will be announced the week of **May 10th** and will be held during lunch hour from 11:45-12:15 in the gym. These dates are to give out information to all the acts and/or approve the content of the act. <u>These are not open practice sessions</u>. Students are responsible for organizing the members of their act and practicing at home or at times other than the final rehearsal and approval dates. Keep in mind during your practicing that the stage area is 16 feet long and 12 feet wide.


