- Achieve at or above the diocesan average in 80% of the categories on MAPS tests
- 65% of students meet or exceed their growth projections on MAPS tests
- Use the MAPS data to guide instruction
- Assess next year's hardware replacement needs by March 31st each year
- Evaluate next year's software needs by May 15th each year

- Complete implementation of Level 2 Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program for grades 1, 2, and 3
- Increase Sunday Mass attendance and parish life activity such as Evening of Worship
- Provide an annual faith retreat for the faculty
- Implement a program that publicly acknowledges students who demonstrate living Christ-like actions
- Develop a system that tracks parent volunteerism in the school and parish community
- Provide parent opportunities outside the classroom for students' faith formation and social justice

2022-2027 Objectives

- Identify and implement programs that help students develop life skills (manners, communication, morals, responsible internet usage, financial literacy, etc.)
- Increase opportunities for students to improve mental and emotional health by learning the basics of Cognitive Behavioral Therapy during quarterly presentations
- Ensure that all students get a minimum of 75 minutes of vigorous movement each week
- Provide opportunities for meditation and mindfulness to decrease stress
