As a reminder, the registration fee and tuition setup will be done later, after the transition to the NEW School Admin Tuition program is complete. We are NOT using "Smart Tuition" next year, so please do not try to re-enroll as in past years. Additional information and instructions regarding School Admin Tuition registration will be communicated soon. Thank you for your patience as we update our system.

Summer Care will begin on Monday, June 13, 2022 and will end on Wednesday, August 17, 2022. The Summer Care Program is available for Holy Spirit School children in Preschool (3 years of age and toilet-trained) through 8th grade. All children enrolled in Summer Care must be fully enrolled for the fall 2022-2023 school year. The center hours are 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (closed Monday, July 4). The variety show entry form is to be turned into the school office by **Friday**, **April 29**th. Please be sure to fill out the form and read this letter completely with your parents, so you understand all the rules. Each participant must have his/her parent's signature.

Acts should be no longer than 2 minutes. Parents, please listen to the music your child has chosen as well as approving dance moves, jokes, and costuming. If deemed inappropriate and/or suggestive, your child will be asked to choose different music, dance moves, and/or costuming.

Rehearsal and approval dates will be announced the week of **May 9th** and will be held during lunch hour from 11:45-12:15 in the gym. These dates are to give out information to all the acts and/or approve the content of the act. These are not open practice sessions. Students are responsible for organizing the members of their act and practicing at home or at times other than the final rehearsal and approval dates. Keep in mind during your practicing that the stage area is 16 feet long and 12 feet wide.

If you have any questions or concerns, we will be happy to help you.


