SEVERE WEATHER UPDATE

In the event that it is necessary to delay the start of school or cancel classes, Holy Spirit School will communicate with you through Grand Rapids area radio and television stations. You may also access school closing announcements through the following Web Sites:

Every effort will be made to make one of the following announcements by 6:00 a.m. or as soon as possible thereafter...

Situation/Condition	Response/Policy		
If the announcement is Holy Spirit School is closed:	Students do not report for school that day. This always includes Preschool and Child Care Programs as well.		
If the Public School District you reside in is closed in your area:	No Catholic Schools Transportation in the A.M. or P.M. into the closed Public School District areas.		
Catholic Schools have a two-hour delay:	Catholic Schools Transportation will begin transporting two hours after regular time. There will be no AM Preschool or AM Kindergarten. Child Care will open at regular time for those enrolled in the program.		
If the Public School District you reside in has a two-hour delay and Catholic Schools are on a regular schedule:	No Catholic Schools Transportation into the delayed district for the A.M. ONLY.		

If school is closed because of inclement weather, all extra-curricular activities, including athletic events and practices, scheduled for Holy Spirit or for Holy Spirit teams on that day, will be cancelled. (Board of Directors policy #2060.1)

On those winter days when school is open but you feel weather conditions are unsafe for your child to go to school, you may keep him or her home. However, we ask that you call school and let us know that you are keeping your child home. While we do require you to call school when your child will be absent, please do not call school to ask if classes will be cancelled due to inclement weather. Instead, please monitor your email, our Facebook page, the Grand Rapids area radio and television stations, or their websites, which will be informed immediately of any cancellations or delays.

Spanish Class News at Holy Spirit: January 2023

¡Feliz Año Nuevo! It's hard to believe that we are halfway through the school year as I type this! We continue to keep learning during Spanish class! Here is what we have been doing this month.

Kindergarten- We are reviewing color words and are now practicing the basic shapes with the colors; for example, el cuadrado rojo (the red square). We played colors and shapes bingo to practice listening to the vocabulary and matching the picture on our boards. We've also been practicing counting higher than 10 and singing the days of the week in Spanish during calendar time.

First grade- Hopefully your child told you about what we did with our shoes earlier this month! We finished up our pizza unit and are starting Unit 3 which is about emotions. This unit will be a little easier as students have been practicing basic emotions for the past few months as I ask them, "Como estas?" We recently learned a new movement song called "Una mano arriba" (One hand up).

Second-Third grades- Students colored un zapato (shoe) to leave out for the Wise Men for Three Kings Day on January 6. I heard back that some of your households had the Wise Men visit there! We are currently learning winter clothing and 2 new songs about winter. See if your child can say 1 or more words in Spanish about what they should wear outside en el invierno (winter)!

Fourth grade- In fourth grade, students have been practicing months, seasons and how to write the date in Spanish. We've learned some songs and played some games to help practice these concepts.

Fifth-Seventh grades- We have started our new unit (2.5) focusing on the following core vocabulary words: va=he/she goes, no puede= cannot, hay=there is/are. Students are hearing/seeing/saying the vocabulary in context and will soon create a class story with the vocabulary. 6th -8th graders will be receiving a letter grade for 2nd quarter. Their grade includes work from the first semester of school. If you would like to discuss your child's grade with me, please sign up to meet with me during conferences next month.

Eighth grade- We continue learning through Unit 3 vocabulary and activities. I brought in a Rosca de Reyes for January 6 for the 8th graders to try, along with some corn tamales. Three 8th grade ladies found the babies in the sweet bread and have to bring in a treat for Friday, February 2, which is the last day of the Christmas season in Mexico! Students are reading longer stories in Spanish and answering questions/understanding the gist of the story.
