New Volunteers: If you plan to go on field trips this spring, and have not completed the diocesan requirements for volunteers, please do so now. Waiting until right before the trip may not allow enough time for the background checks to be completed in time. Go to virtus.org and click on First Time Registrant on the left side. Volunteers **only** may do this online.

It is that time of year to be thinking about summer activities and vacations. The CDC staff has been busy planning activities for the 2023 Summer Care Program. Summer Care will begin on Monday, June 12, 2023, and will end on Wednesday, August 16, 2023. The Summer Care Program is available for Holy Spirit children in Preschool (3 years of age and toilet-trained) through 8th grade. All children enrolled in Summer Care must be fully enrolled for the fall 2023-2024 school year. The center hours are 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday (closed Monday, July 3 and Tuesday, July 4). Each day will be filled with special activities for all the children. There are weekly destination field trip opportunities for children enrolled on a regular basis in child care and are entering 1st through 8th grade in the fall 2023-2024 school year. Spanish Class News at Holy Spirit: March 2023

Kindergarten- Mrs. Kalahar always asks the students to tell her a word they learned in Spanish class that day; ask your child to tell you a word as well each Tuesday! Their word this week was soy which means I am, as in Soy Timbo (I am Timbo). We practiced it in class this week and I use soy + child's name to pass back papers. We learned a new song about Imagination Glasses and students have been reviewing colors by coloring objects from that song.

First grade- We've been learning about the main meals (desayuno-breakfast, almuerzo-lunch and cena-dinner). We are learning a song called "Jugo de Naranja" which can be practiced on youtube. We give our feedback on food and drinks in Spanish (me gusta, no me gusta, me encanta, que asco, etc).

Second-Third grades-We have been learning vocabulary in 2 cartoon episodes about Timbo going to Earth and Wants to Paint. Have your child tell you about the main idea in these episodes and any vocabulary words/colors they remember in Spanish.

Fourth grade- In 4th grade, we have been learning about Senorita Amarilla and Senor Azul in 3 continuous episodes which tell their story. We've been identifying vocabulary and practicing speaking using flashcards to retell the third episode. Next week, we will wrap up with the 4th and final episode.


Fifth-Seventh grades- Students are finishing Unit 2.5 and reviewing vocabulary through online practice/games. 5th/6th grades will identify the Spanish speaking countries next and research one of the countries. 7th grade will continue next with Unit 3 vocabulary.

Eighth grade- Both classes are in Unit 4 which focuses on professions. Students continue to read Spanish in context, write in simple sentences, and answer questions using short phrases in Spanish. Students also practice retelling/summarizing what they read in English.

Rehearsal and approval dates will be announced the week of **May 8th** and will be held during lunch hour from 11:45-12:15 in the gym. These dates are to give out information to all the acts and/or approve the content of the act. <u>These are not open practice sessions</u>. Students are responsible for organizing the members of their act and practicing at home or at times other than the final rehearsal and approval dates. Keep in mind during your practicing that the stage area is 16 feet long and 12 feet wide.
