- If you cannot find the email, the easiest way is to log into your Virtus account. If you have forgotten your user name, I can email it to you. You will have to change your password if you do not remember it.
- Once in your account, you should see a pinkish square that will ask if your name matches your driver's license. Change it to match if needed.
- Continue going through the pages and checking the appropriate boxes, filling in the information required, and finish by submitting at the end. It will tell you if you have been successful in your submission.
- If you do not see the pinkish square, there might be something wrong with your email address. Contact <a href="mailto:dschoof@hsparish.org">dschoof@hsparish.org</a> with the correct email, and I will have them resend the link. If your child's grandparents or other relatives have previously signed up to volunteer, please remind them to complete this update or tell us to remove them from the volunteer list.
- Even if your child will be going to a Catholic high school next year, please do it now as it will stay with your account. Anyone not completed by June 1 will be ineligible to volunteer or work in the diocese until it is completed which will then be at a higher cost to the parish or school.

#### Spanish Class News at Holy Spirit: April 2023

**Kindergarten**- We continue to practice/review our colors in Spanish through songs, games and coloring! See how many colors your child can say to you in Spanish!

**First grade-** We are listening to and acting out the unit story about mama and her bebe. We learned about the painter/sculptor Fernando Botero. Soon, you will see items come home in which your child can start to use the vocabulary we've been learning.

**Second-Third grades**- Students have been learning/reviewing vocabulary about the weather in the song, "Mira, mira, mira, por la ventana" (Look, look, look out the window). Your child should be able to ask the question, "What's the weather?" (Que tiempo hace?) and tell some basic weather phrases in Spanish.

**Fourth grade-** Fourth graders have finished with the 4 episodes of Senorita Amarilla and Senor Azul. We were exposed to a lot of vocabulary in Spanish! We learned about Easter Traditions in the Spanish speaking countries and are currently reviewing/learning greetings vocabulary such as hasta luego (see you later), que tal? (what's up?) and mucho gusto (nice to meet you).

**Fifth grade-** Fifth graders recently learned more about the Spanish speaking countries through presentations of their peers. We've been practicing a song about the countries and one called, "Puedo ir al bano?"-ask your 5 th grader about the meaning of it.

**Sixth-Seventh grades-** Students are working through Unit 3 vocabulary (abre la puerta, nunca cierra, son las...) please quiz your child on these terms! We've been practicing the vocabulary in stories and class activities. We will be learning about the Panama Canal soon in Spanish with this unit.

**Eighth grade-** We continue working with the following vocabulary terms in Unit 4: toma, habla, quiere ser. Please quiz your student on these terms! Recently, students wrote 3-4 sentences in Spanish about a character of their choosing. They wrote about some likes/dislikes about this character, who they might speak to in their line of work, what profession this character is in and some classes he/she would take for this profession. We continue to read text in Spanish to understand the gist and answer questions about it, all in Spanish. Students write in English about what they understood.
