<u>Kindergarten/First grades</u>- Students have been learning Farm animals and the sounds they make in Spanish! See if your child can identify a few and share the song with you when you see their Spanish class paper about the animals come home!

<u>Second-Third grades</u>- We have been learning vocabulary related to Spring (La Primavera). Your child may be able to identify a few vocabulary words about the season. Students also practiced and read their mini-book about this season and should have shared it with you by now. We are currently learning the fruits in Spanish with a fun song we practice.

<u>Fourth grade</u>- In Fourth grade, students learned vocabulary related to Spring (La Primavera). You should have seen a packet come home recently about this theme. Currently, we are reviewing Colors and School Objects.




