

Every effort will be made to make one of the following announcements by 6:00 a.m. or as soon as possible thereafter...

Situation/Condition	Response/Policy		
If the announcement is Holy Spirit School is closed:	Students do not report for school that day. This always includes Preschool and Child Care Programs as well.		
If the Public School District you reside in is closed in your area:	No Catholic Schools Transportation in the A.M. or P.M. into the closed Public School District areas.		
Catholic Schools have a two-hour delay:	Catholic Schools Transportation will begin transporting two hours after regular time. There will be no AM Preschool or AM Kindergarten. Child Care will open at regular time for those enrolled in the program.		
If the Public School District you reside in has a two-hour delay and Catholic Schools are on a regular schedule:	· · ·		

If school is closed because of inclement weather, all extra-curricular activities, including athletic events and practices, scheduled for Holy Spirit or for Holy Spirit teams on that day, will be cancelled. (Board of Directors policy #2060.1)

On those winter days when school is open but you feel weather conditions are unsafe for your child to go to school, you may keep him or her home. However, we ask that you call school and let us know that you are keeping your child home. While we do require you to call school when your child will be absent, please do not call school to ask if classes will be cancelled due to inclement weather. Instead, please monitor your email, our Facebook page, the Grand Rapids area radio and television stations, or their websites, which will be informed immediately of any cancellations or delays.

      - Goal is that the Dicoesan Office makes the call by 6am
- Holy Spirit School Athletics

- Fee per athlete/ school year is and has been \$85.00/ year (All you can play) for many years
- This rate is not sustainable
  - 2022-2023 School year, Holy Spirit School lost almost \$7,000 on athletics, not included an athletic director's salary or uniforms
  - In order to break even, the fee would need to have been \$185.00/ athlete
- The Board of Directors have been working on a plan for the 2023-2024 Athletic Season(s)
  - Possibility of keeping a 1/year fee (All you can play)
  - Possibility of a per sport fee (different for each individual sport, depending on their needs)
- Athletic Boosters Golf Outing
  - Booster's primary goal has been fundraising
  - 2023 Golf Outing helped reduce the athletic deficit- THANK YOU! THANK YOU! THANK YOU!
- GRACEAC (5th-8th grade) pays for (generally speaking, different per sport): uniforms, equipment, director's salary, referees, facilities (line painting)
  - The cost of reconditioning a football helmet alone is astronomical!

#### Spanish Class News at Holy Spirit: January 2024

<u>Kindergarten</u>- We continue to learn the color words azul, blanco, rojo and verde for the winter months. The children are also learning a winter song in Spanish called "Invierno" to learn some winter weather phrases. As of late, we are learning the phrase for snowman (muñeco de nieve) as there are many in the library for us to see and find!

<u>First-</u> We are learning winter weather clothing such as: gorra (winter hat), bufanda (scarf), pantalones (pants), botas (boots), and guantes (gloves). We are learning a few songs about winter as well.

<u>Second</u>- We just finished up our unit on numbers and will be starting to learn about the adventures of Chispa (a friendly monster) from the <u>rockalingua.com</u> site I use in class with them.

<u>Third</u>- We've been wrapping up the numbers up through 59, and will next move into a quick unit with St. Valentine's Day coming soon in regards to friendship between a girl and her cat. This unit will also review the colors and introduce new vocabulary as well.

**Fourth-** Fourth graders continue to learn about Srta. Amarilla and Sr. Azul in the adventures they have together. Students are learning songs and new vocabulary through these episodes. We recently made flashcards with episode 2 and will be listening to the storyline and showing the cards that illustrate the Spanish.

**<u>Fifth</u>**- Students are about to wrap up Unit 2 with a quiz this last week in January. Students did a pretest back in November over this unit and they've been told that if they all show measurable growth on the post test, we will celebrate with a popcorn/hot chocolate party which they are excited about!

<u>Sixth</u>- Sixth graders just started Unit 4 recently. We missed Spanish classes last week due to testing and are now getting into the core vocabulary, Spanish professions and being able to answer the question, ("Que quieres ser?") (What do you want to be?)

<u>Seventh/Eighth</u>- These students also did not have Spanish last week due to semester tests and we are now getting back into Unit 5 vocabulary (7<sup>th</sup> grade and 8<sup>th</sup> grade first hour) and continuing through Unit 6 (8<sup>th</sup> grade fourth hour).
