My name is Gabe Augdahl and I am currently a Freshman at Central Michigan University. In the summer of 2021, I was diagnosed with a desmoid tumor - a very rare soft tissue tumor, rare as in 5 in a million people a year are diagnosed. I have been through 4 different therapies with little to no improvement, however the doctors are considering it stable at this time. Although the tumor is stable, the prognosis has not changed. The uncertainty of this tumor makes it difficult to know from scan to scan whether to stay the path of treatment I am on or reconsider other therapies. Overall, my life in general has not been affected from this disease and I am grateful for that. There has been some positive research and a new FDA approved medication solely for desmoid tumors is now available. I am hopeful that one day, through continued awareness and research a cure for Desmoid Tumor will become available to all patients with this disease.
