## Spanish Class News at Holy Spirit – May/June 2024

<u>Kindergarten-</u> We finish with identifying/saying all the basic colors in Spanish, numbers to 20, days of the week, months of the year, learning the Primavera (Spring) song, identifying Spring vocabulary and reviewing favorite songs/games we've learned this year!

<u>First-</u> We listen to and act out a story in Spanish about a girl not liking anything to eat! We've learned some songs using the phrases, "me gusta, no me gusta". We end by reviewing learned topics through songs and games that we've done this year.

**Second-** Students continue to review colors, numbers to 50, days of the week, and basic weather phrases. Students also have seen episode 3 of Chispa in which Chispa does some magic. We also end the year reviewing learned topics through songs and games.

**Third-** Third graders finish with learning numbers up to 100 and recognizing numbers up to 1,000. We've covered a lot of topics this year including the Spanish alphabet, weather phrases, practice saying numbers when guessing the temperature outside, seasons, and reviewing days of the week.

**Fourth-** As of late, fourth graders have been learning numbers up to 100. We practice writing, spelling by listening to the letters in Spanish, and using the accent marks over certain vowels when appropriate.

**<u>Fifth-</u>** We are at the end of Unit 2.5. Students will take a practice quiz very soon over the vocabulary learned. Next year in Middle School, students will start to receive letter grades on the report card for Spanish class. Please contact me if you are interested in summer practice for your child to keep up

with their Spanish skills

<u>Sixth -</u> Sixth graders will be taking a listening/reading quiz soon over the vocabulary in Unit 5. Please contact me if you are interested in summer practice for your child to keep up with their Spanish skills as we will build off this year's learning into 7<sup>th</sup> grade Spanish.

<u>Seventh/Eighth-</u> Students recently learned the Spanish alphabet. We learned a song to sing the alphabet, practiced listening and spelling words in Spanish, and eventually took a quiz to check their knowledge of identifying the correct letters/sounds in Spanish.

<u>4<sup>th</sup> hour Spanish 8 students –</u> Students finished unit 8 and have been introduced to unit 9 vocabulary. I'm so proud of these 8 students I had this year and the growth they've all shown in their Spanish skills! Best of luck to them in high school Spanish!

I wish all the 8<sup>th</sup> graders good luck (Buena Suerte!) as they leave Holy Spirit school and venture off to High School!!!!

Have a wonderful summer enjoying time with your precious children! I am honored to be a part of your child's Spanish learning and look forward to seeing them again in the fall!






