If school is closed because of inclement weather, all extra-curricular activities, including athletic events and practices, scheduled for Holy Spirit or for Holy Spirit teams on that day, will be cancelled. (Education Commission policy #2060.1)

On those winter days when school is open but you feel weather conditions are unsafe for your child to go to school, you may keep him or her home. However, we ask that you call school and let us know that you are keeping your child at home. While we do urge you to call school when your child will be absent, please don't call the school to ask if classes will be cancelled because of the weather. Instead, we urge you to monitor Grand Rapids area radio and television stations, or their web sites, which will be informed immediately of any cancellations or delays.

Spanish Class News at Holy Spirit – October 2024

Here is what has been happening with Spanish class in the month of October!

<u>KDG</u>- We continue to practice numbers to 10, colors (have added verde and marron/café) and are learning the song, "Alrededor" in which the students do different movements around the library-ask your child about this song!

<u>1st-3rd grades</u>- Pretty soon you will see your child's work come home from the Parts of the Body Unit that we have almost completed. Students should be able to identify on their own some of the body parts and if you know Spanish, you can quiz them to see how many they can identify! We also learned about the Royal Family in Spain (Espana) and students were able to understand simple descriptions of the family in Spanish.

 $4^{\text{th}_{-}}$ We continue to work through the first unit of Vamos. Soon, we will start to learn some cultural Christmas songs to prepare for caroling in December around the school!

<u>5th-6th grades</u>- We are in Unit 2 which focuses on animals/body parts and sounds. The cultural section will be on Costa Rica about a special lantern parade which students will learn about in November. Students will receive a grade for first quarter in Spanish.

<u>7th grade Second hour</u>- We are also in Unit 2 (see 5th-6th grade note above). Students recently did a Spanish speaking country report and are reporting out their findings to their classmates.

<u>7th grade Third hour</u>- We are currently in Unit 3 which starts to focus more specifically on calendar phrases and asking/answering about physical descriptions. Students will soon learn about the country of Peru.

<u>8th grade</u>- Eighth graders will take the Unit 2 assessment the last Tuesday in October. We will soon start on Unit 3 (see 7th grade 3rd hour notes above).

Feel free to meet with me during conferences! I will be available on Thurs. Nov. 7 only.

Students in grades 5-8 will receive letter grades for all 4 quarters for Spanish class.
